

Accreditation Guidelines of the European TRIZ-Campus e.V.

The following accreditation guidelines are subject to constant further development; the latest status is valid in each case.

Requirements

The following requirements must be met for accreditation:

- Candidate has TRIZ level 3.
- Candidate is a member of the European TRIZ-Campus e.V. (ETC)
- Candidate accepts and behaves according to the quality guidelines of the ETC.
- Candidate makes a sworn statement that the quality guidelines are accepted and that the trainings comply with the guidelines of the ETC.
- Candidate submits an exemplary test including suggested solutions for the respective level.

If the candidate is not known to the ETC, the following additional requirements apply:

- Proof of teaching experience (academic or professional)
- Alternatively, a "trial lecture" on the occasion of the "trainer workshop"
- The Board of Directors or a committee appointed by the Board of Directors shall decide on the necessity of a trial lecture.

Tests

- The Board of Directors decides on the suitability of the submitted test for the respective level:
 - Is the curriculum of the respective level covered?
 - Test must not be an obvious copy of an existing test.
 - The candidate's own contribution must be recognizable.
- The test will be marked CCO and made available to the ETC.

Proliferation of accreditation

- Trainers must participate in a "trainer workshop" at least once every two years.
- Trainers actively participate in the trainer workshop in order to share knowledge and experience.

Trainer Workshop

- The ETC organizes a "trainer workshop" as an online event.
- The event is held in the afternoon/evening, e.g., 4-8 p.m.
- All members of the ETC can participate in the event.
- A date for the trainer workshop will be arranged as soon as at least 4 candidates for accreditation have registered.
- The date will be communicated to all members with 14 days' notice.
- Candidates present at the trainer workshop e.g.
 - Didactic or methodological examples
 - The own training concept with documents, examples, procedure, exemplary chapter, ...
 - "How can others benefit from my knowledge?"
 - "What happened to me?" - Successes and Fuckups

Loss of accreditation

Trainers lose accreditation if at least one of the following criteria is present:

- Trainer disregards the bylaws of the ETC
- Trainer does not adhere to the quality guidelines of the ETC
- Trainer has not participated in a trainer workshop within the last two years
